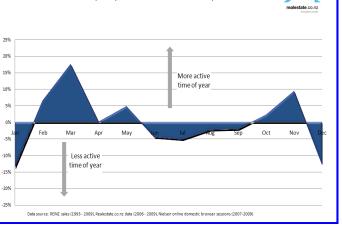


Is Summer really the best time to sell your home?

According to www.unconditional.co.nz if you ask an assembled group of property owners when is the best time of year to buy or sell property they'll likely say summer. However real estate agents are actually pretty busy selling property year round.

The fact is that property sales are actually less susceptible to seasonality than some may think. In the chart below the calendar year is laid out showing the peaks and troughs of sales – this data is showing seasonality; based on over 15 years of data from the Real Estate Institute.

REINZ Hawkes Bay Residential Sales Region Analysis for July 2012

Sales volume in Hawkes Bay increased by 4.5% compared to June, with the increase in sales in Napier offsetting lower sales elsewhere in the region. Compared to July 2011 sales were 10.5% higher, again largely due to the lift in sales in Napier, which increased by almost 18%

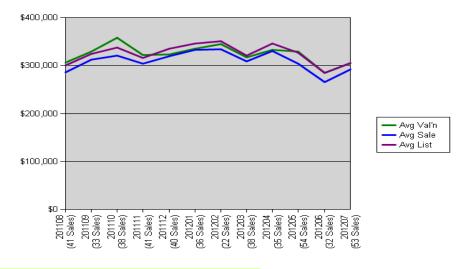
The median price increased by \$4,500 compared to June, but eased by \$5,500 compared to July 2011. The median days to sell for Hawkes Bay eased back from 56 days in June to 62 days in July. The overall trend in the number of days to sell is now easing. Since March the number of days to sell has increased from 45 days to 62

Valuation to Sale Comparison Napier - Aug 2011 to Jul 2012

The graph to the right covers all Napier residential sales in the year to July 2012. There are a couple of observation to be made:

- The price that properties are valued at has become very closely aligned with the price they're being listed at
- The gap between average sale price and average list price remains constant indicating prices are not being dropped excessively to gain a sale
